



Partner Checklist

Raptor

Raptor's arrival time will be coordinated between you and the Tour Manager well in advance of our performance. On the day of our performance, you or your designated point of contact must be available to meet the band when they arrive to provide access to the venue and any other areas they need access to (dressing rooms, bathrooms, etc.). The following list includes the band's standard requirements needed to ensure the highest quality performance.

Stage: Raptor's preferred performance area is 24 feet wide and 16 feet deep. If you have concerns about the size of your performance area, our Tour Manager will discuss options with you on how the band can fit into your particular venue. In addition to the performance stage, we need an area near the stage to store equipment and instrument cases. Stairs create a safety hazard and hinder set-up. Please inform the Tour Manager if there are stairs between the loading area and the stage as this may require us to consider an alternate performance location.

Construction: The stage area must be level with a firm foundation with level access to the loading area. For outdoor sites the performance area must be dry. The band cannot perform in inclement weather (to include high winds). We recommend arranging for an alternate indoor site in the event of inclement weather.

Cleanliness: The performance stage and dressing areas should be clean and uncluttered before arrival of the band. If the band is performing at an event with other entertainers (such as festivals, picnics, park concerts, etc), please ensure the stage area is cleared of all other equipment prior to Raptor's designated set-up time.

Set-up: Raptor requires access to your venue 2 ½ hours prior to their performance to accomplish their set-up, sound check and a change into performance uniforms. Depending on the scheduled time of the performance, it may be necessary to schedule an earlier arrival time to allow our members to eat a meal and return in time to change for the performance.

Lighting: Other than the need for general stage lighting (full wash), the band does not require any special lighting. Please designate someone who can turn on the lights for the band's performance.

Audio/Electrical: Raptor will provide all audio equipment. Please allow for space in the audience seating for our sound board and space immediately surrounding the stage for our speakers. Raptor needs 4 separate 120V/20Amp circuits to power their audio system. Power should be located very near or on the stage.

Dressing Rooms: The band needs two securable dressing rooms, one for males and one for females.

Parking: Please provide parking for our vehicles at the performance site. The band uses one 24-foot long 5-ton box truck and one 15-passenger van. If possible, we would prefer to leave the equipment truck in place after unloading.
