VOCALIST AUDITION

Resumes and recordings must be delivered by December 19, 2014. Applicants who qualify for the live audition will be contacted by the USAF Band auditions team and then by an Air Force recruiter to assess each applicant's eligibility to enlist in the Air Force. Once approved by the recruiter, applicants will receive an audition invitation letter. All invited candidates must be prepared to meet Air Force maximum allowable weight standards.

PRE-SCREENING REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

1. Resume
2. Audio recordings of 4-6 songs (15-20 minutes of music) in a variety of styles including the following:
 - a. One rock/pop/country song
 - b. One jazz standard
 - c. One classical or theater piece
 - d. An a cappella version of The Star Spangled Banner
 - e. Additional tracks may be added at the candidate's discretion.
